I also want to comment on our set. I'm sure you've noticed that it is "different", and no, we didn't run out of money to finish it. I have tried to stay true to what the author, William Gibson, wanted. I quote from his notes..."the staging is one of cutting through time and place, its qualities are fluidity and spatial counterpoint. To this end, the less set there is, the better. The stage should be free, airy, unencumbered by walls...locales should be only skeletal suggestions, and the movement from one to another should be accomplished by little more than lights." This also challenges the audience to imagine more for themselves and to focus more on the acting, the characters and this beautiful and amazing story.

I hope you come away from tonight more inspired because of the steadfastness and dedication of Annie Sullivan to teach her pupil, Helen Keller, though deaf and blind, a way to communicate with other people and with her world, because we all could use a lesson in communicating with each other and our world.

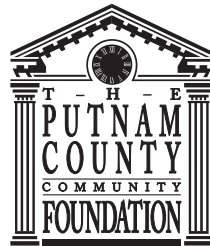
